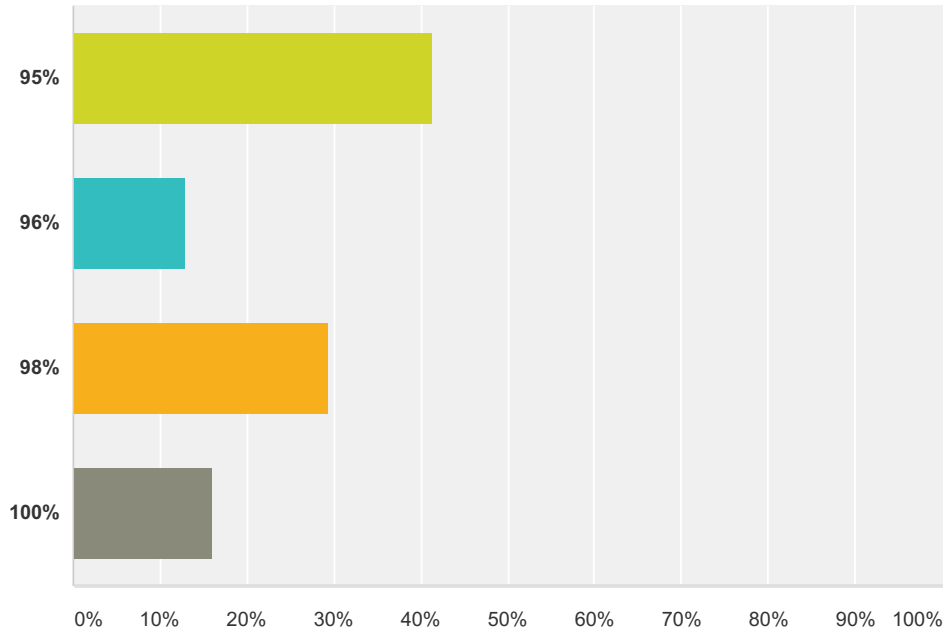

Our current attendance rates at both schools are approx 97.5% so it would not seem sensible to expect anything much below this.

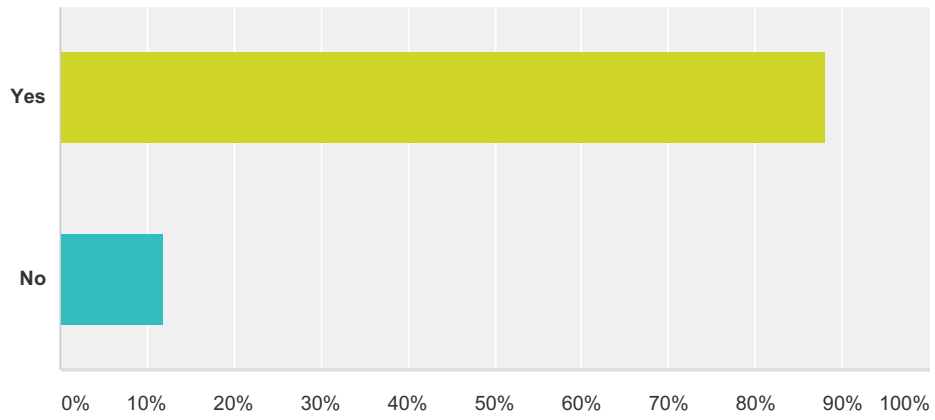
45.55% of parents considered 98% or higher to be what should be expected by the school

Answered: 292 Skipped: 0

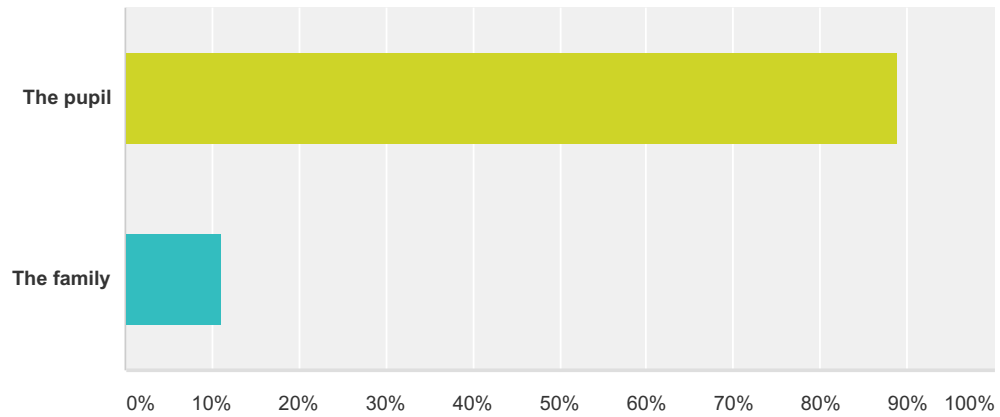
