1) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{7}{14}$

2) $\frac{3}{5} = \frac{30}{50}$

3) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{8}{16}$

4) $\frac{4}{5} = \frac{12}{15}$

5) $\frac{1}{5} = \frac{6}{30}$

6) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{6}{12}$

7) $\frac{2}{5} = \frac{12}{30}$

8) $\frac{4}{5} = \frac{8}{10}$

9) $\frac{4}{5} = \frac{20}{25}$

10) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{4}{8}$

11) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{10}{20}$

12) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4}$

13) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{3}{6}$
