TUESDAY 30TH JUNE SLIDE 1/2

BEING RESPECTFUL ONLINE (30 MINS)

- What does it mean to be 'respectful' to other people including our friends?
- Create a spider diagram/word web with the word 'respectful' at the centre. Note ideas around it about what it means to be 'respectful to others'.
- Remember that it is just as important to remember these things when we are communicating online. The consequences of being disrespectful online can be just as upsetting and hurtful as if it were in a real life, face to face situation.
- If we are being respectful to others online, we should only be making positive contributions to conversations or to groups.
