Discovery Topic: Where  
our wellies take us...

This term our topic is 'Where our wellies take us...'. We will be looking at the UK and its different regions, rivers, mountains and seas. Below is a list of home learning activities. Complete four of the activities below (at least one of which must be writing based). These need to be returned to school before the end of term, although they can come in before as and when they are completed. If you need any resources in order to complete these activities, then let us know as we can provide these for you. Creative projects should be photographed and sent in on the class email address and these will be shared with the class during assembly time.

Create a fact file about a mountain in the world but not Mt Everest.	Write a diary entry of a mountain explorer. Think about the daily activities they might complete on a climb and also think about some of the things they might feel or see.	WILDCARD  Do you have a much better idea than we have had related to our topic? If so, this is your chance to WOW us with your creativity. Create your own piece of homework linked to our topic.	Design your own surfboard.	Use mixed media to create a river picture.
Write an acrostic poem - mountains	Draw or make a human skeleton. Name the bones.	Write a Non-Chronological report on a sea animal of your choice.	Make your favourite sea creature. You can do this any way you wish!	Write a story with the title 'The Lost Sea Creature'.

As well as these, the expectations for Reading remain that same. Children should read at home to an adult at least three times per week (ideally 5). Please record and sign their Reading Record after each read.
