Discovery Topic: Magnificent Me!

Below is a list of home learning activities. This term we would like you to complete four of the activities below (at least one of which must be writing based). These need to be returned to school by the end of term, although they can come in before as and when they are completed.

Write a list about people of in your family.	Make a 'feelings Monster. (based on our book - 'The Colour Monster')	Make a family tree showing who is in your family.	Create a map of your journey to school.	Create a picture of you in the future.
Create a map of your house or bedroom.	Design your own classroom and label what you would have in it.	Help to make your favourite food at home.	Record how many steps it takes to get from your bedroom to the front door.	Write about what you would like to do when you are older.

As well as these, the expectations for Reading remain the same. Children must read at home to an adult at least three times per week (ideally 5). Please record and sign their Reading Record after each read.
