Discovery Topic: Frozen Planet

Below is a list of home learning activities. This term we would like you to complete four of the activities below (at least one of which must be writing based). These need to be returned to school by the end of term, although they can come in before as and when they are completed.

Write a list of things you would take on an adventure to the South Pole.	What would be the best way to travel across snow & ice? Draw & label (or even invent) a mode of transport that would be perfect for the job.	Find out about animals that live at the North and South Poles. Write down 5 facts about one of those animals.	Create a picture of an arctic animal. Be as creative as you like!	Design or make a sandwich that you would take on a long journey.
Look around your house for different 2D and 3D shape objects. Write them down or take photos of them.	Create a list of the different animals you see on the walk to school/home.	Write a story about an animal who gets lost.	Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Challenge yourself to do it backwards.	Make a list of instructions for something you do at home.

As well as these, the expectations for Reading remain the same. Children must read at home to an adult at least three times per week (ideally 5). Please record and sign their Reading Record after each read.

Here are some words that you could practise reading and spelling at home to support your learning in class:
