

Discovery Home Learning - Romans

Below is a list of home learning activities. This term we would like you to complete **four of the activities** below (at least two of which must be writing based). These can be sent as they are completed. Please take photos of art/DT projects to share them with us and send these via the class email so we can show the class.

Investigate and make a Roman villa using whatever materials you choose.	Design and draw (map view) or design and build a roman town	Investigate a town/place in the United Kingdom where Roman coins or artefacts have been discovered. Create a fact file.	Design a piece of Roman jewellery and make it.	Investigate to find out if there are any Roman roads near us.
Where can Roman baths be found in England. Write about the 4 main features.	Create a poster showing the clothing worn by a Roman person.	Create a menu for a Roman banquet. Present it in a way the Romans would have seen it.	Create a power point about famous Roman Emperors.	Make a model of a mode of transport the Romans would have used.

In addition to these, the expectations for Reading remain the same. Children should read their AR book or a book for pleasure at home at least 3 times a week (ideally 5). **Please record and sign their Reading Record.**

Multiplication Tables remain a focus. In your year group children should be learning **all** of their multiplication tables by the end of the year. Although we will not have multiplication tables home learning, children will be assessed on their multiplication tables each week. This may be orally, as part of a game or in a written format.

To help your child with their learning, each year group has created a 'how to' guide which is on the school's website. This is designed to help with the methods and some of the key vocabulary used in each year group.
