Topic	Inspired World	Year Group	5	Term 2
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Subject Focus:	History, Geography, English, Science and PE
Rationale: We will be using the stories of 'Good Night Stories for Rebel Girls' and 'Queen of the Falls' to learn about and explore a range of inspirational women. We will look at how they have changed and inspired the world with their beliefs, passions and achievements.	

The key vocabulary that will be taught in this topic:
<u>Key vocabulary from our key books:</u> remarkable, survival, cascading, plunged, fearless, spectators, hypnotised, outstretched, curiosity, disastrous, pounding and discombobulation.
<u>Cross-curricular key vocabulary:</u> oceans, adapt, creatures, Civil Rights Movement, tourism, achievement, sport, inspiration, fossils, gravity, buoyancy.
<u>Key people:</u> Sylvia Earle, Jane Goodall, Maya Angelou, Rosa Parks, Miriam Makeba, Malala Yousafzai, Amna Al Haddad, Simone Biles, Serena and Venus Williams, Yusra Mardini, Margaret Hamilton, Mary Anning, Michelle Obama, Evita Peron and Annie Edson Taylor.

Key knowledge that will be taught in this topic:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use the techniques of folding, repeating and overlapping with a variety of collage mediums (e.g card, tissue paper, corrugated etc.).• Solidly infill shapes using colour pencils, felt pens, pastels etc and produce a range of tones in each.• Sustain different techniques for working in role help to explore complex issues.

- To understand Inspirational figures across the world and time.
- Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object.
- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.
- Be able to describe key aspects of physical features.

Opportunities for home learning:

- Research about the life of Amelia Earhart. Who was she, why is she famous? Create a replica plane using a medium of your choice. Be as creative as you can.
- Find out about a woman that has had a big impact on the area in which your STEAM team is. For example, if you are an engineer, think about a famous engineer. Create a short biography about them.
- Make your own travel brochure booklet to encourage someone to visit a particular country or continent. Can you include some inspirational people from that area?
- The Queen has been the leader of our country and the Commonwealth for more than 70 years. Write a letter to her to tell her what an amazing inspiration she is!
